For your information – with the new Code of Cannon Law and directions concerning the Sacraments in the Roman Rite, the primary minister of Confirmation is the local Bishop except when someone is dying or when a non-Catholic comes into the Church. The priest who instructs them is to confirm them according to the Universal Law of the Church. If someone who is Catholic has never been confirmed, a priest can confirm them with the Bishop's permission. The Bishop may also ask a priest to help him confirm if there is a large number. In the Eastern Rite, under the Pope, the priest baptizes, confirms, and gives First Communion all at the same time.
