Pope Francis names Monsignor William Koenig as Bishop of Wilmington - The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has named the Reverend Monsignor William Edward Koenig, Vicar for Clergy for the Diocese of Rockville Centre, New York, as the Tenth Bishop of Wilmington. The appointment was announced April 30th in Washington, D.C. by Archbishop Christophe Pierre, apostolic nuncio to the United States. Bishop-elect Koenig (*pronounced Kay-nig*) follows the Most Reverend W. Francis Malooly who has served as Bishop of the Catholic community of Delaware and Maryland's Eastern Shore since 2008.
