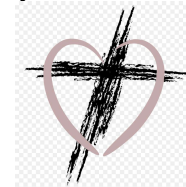
**The Sanctuary Candle** is lit from 2/13-2/26 for the Members of the MacKenzie and Grygo Families by the MacKenzie Family

**Lenten Reminder** - On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: **Everyone of age 14 and up must abstain from consuming meat.** On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone of age 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to usually a medical reason. Ash Wednesday is one of two yearly days of obligatory fasting and abstinence for Roman Catholics, along with Good Friday. **Fasting means** a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they are not to equal that of a full meal.

**Stations of the Cross** - will take place on the Fridays during Lent (except Good Friday) at 7 PM. All are welcome! Please let Deacon know if you wish to participate as a Leader.
