LET FREEDOM RING PRAYER SERVICE - Deacon David Feaster will lead a Let Freedom Ring Prayer Service on Independence Day, **Tuesday**, **July 4th** at St. Francis Xavier Shrine at Old Bohemia Mission in Warwick, MD. The service will start at 1:30 PM. Let Freedom Ring was established to revive the spirit of patriotism and provide a dignified ceremony for millions of Americans who love their country and have faith in its future. The celebration is the only federallymandated Independence Day ceremony. In accordance with U.S. Congressional Resolution Number 25, passed in 1963, bells across the country are rung 13 times at exactly 2:00 PM (EDT), in honor of the thirteen original states. Charles Carroll, from Maryland, was the only Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence so it is fitting to celebrate at this historic site, the earliest permanent Catholic foundation in the English Colonies outside of the Jesuit establishments in Charles and St. Mary's counties in lower Maryland.
