Message from Fr. Dave

This Wednesday I will begin my assignment as the administrator of Saint Paul Parish. I'm honored and excited to serve our parish family here in Delaware City. For thirty years I was a diocesan priest in the Pittsburgh Diocese, serving as a pastor, assistant pastor, college campus minister and as a chaplain and religion teacher at two Catholic high schools.

Eleven years ago, I made the decision to join the religious community at Daylesford Abbey in Paoli, PA to become a Norbertine priest. During that time, I worked at the Abbey, later serving as the Prior. For the past three years, I was assigned to Cabrini University in Radnor, PA as the university chaplain where I also taught first year students. Last December, I transferred to Immaculate Conception Priory, a Norbertine Community in Middletown, DE.

I look forward to meeting all of you in the next several months. After serving as the administrator for the first year here at St. Paul, I should be appointed as the pastor of our parish. I have always had a great devotion to Saint Paul. I have three siblings and my one brother is named Paul. May our Lord continue to bless our parish community as we transition into a new period for our worshipping community.
