This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This Solemnity marks the end of another Church Liturgical. Next Sunday we will begin a “new” Church Liturgical Year with the Season of Advent.

As I mentioned last week, the Wilmington Diocese is celebrating this week our Diocesan Eucharistic Adoration Week. Our parish will have a special Eucharistic Day on Thursday, November 30th. The day will begin with Mass at 7am. After the Mass, we will have all day Eucharistic Adoration in our church. Plan to stop by sometime during the day to pray in the presence of our Lord in the Eucharist. The day will conclude with the celebration of Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament at 7pm.

As we celebrate Our Lord Jesus Christ King of the Universe, let us pray, “Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the Universe, Who sanctified us with His commandments, and hoped for us, and with love and intent invested us with His sacred Sabbath, as a memorial to the deed of Creation.”
