This weekend we begin our 2024 Faith and Charity Appeal that supports all the good works of our Diocese. I thank you in advance for your support.

I would like to share with you some items that were discussed at a recent meeting of our Pastoral Council. Planning continues with replacing the outside statue of the Blessed Mother. We hope to soon make a final decision on purchasing an outside color statue. Unfortunately, we are not able to find an exact replica of the damaged statue that was removed. We believe we have found a similar outside color statue close to the same size of the former statue. We also would like to do some significant landscaping around the statue along with new brick walkways. We are inviting parishioners to meet outside of the Church after the 9am Mass on Sunday, April 28th to give us some feedback on our ideas. We also decided at the meeting to celebrate Pentecost Sunday this year (May 19th) with refreshments outside of the Church after the 5pm Saturday Mass and coffee and donuts after the 9am Sunday Mass.
