This Monday will be our second Lenten Eucharistic Adoration Day. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will begin at 4pm in the Church. A Lenten Reflection will begin at 7pm. Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament will conclude the day after the Lenten Reflection. The Eucharist is very central to us in our Faith.
