Next weekend we will celebrate Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. Palms will be blessed at the 5pm Saturday Vigil Mass. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. Please note the following Holy Week Schedule. The Sacrament of Penance (Confessions) will be available at our Parish in the Church from 6pm to 8pm on Monday of Holy Week. The Holy Thursday Mass will be at 7pm. The Good Friday Liturgy (including Holy Communion) will be at 7pm. The Easter Vigil Mass will begin at 7:30pm and the Easter Sunday Mass will be celebrated at 9am. Please note that on Holy Week, we will not have the 8:30am Thursday Lenten Daily Mass and there will not be a 5pm Mass on Holy Saturday.
