He is truly risen, Alleluia! May you and your family have a blessed Easter. Many thanks to all who helped to prepare for our Holy Week and Easter Liturgies.

The 2024 Pascal Candle is blessed and lit at the Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday. The Pascal Candle will be lit at all Masses (weekday and Sunday) throughout the Easter Season. On Easter Sunday, Jesus rises from the dead – His wounds from the nails in His hands and feet are visible in His new glorified and resurrected body. The Church celebrates her Easter Joy for 50 days!

NEXT SUNDAY IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY. It is a special time to reach out and invite family, friends and strangers to know God's love and forgiveness through His Son. Having just celebrated Easter and receiving the Eucharist this devotion and confession is meant for those who did not participate in the sacraments at Easter but through your invitation may respond.
